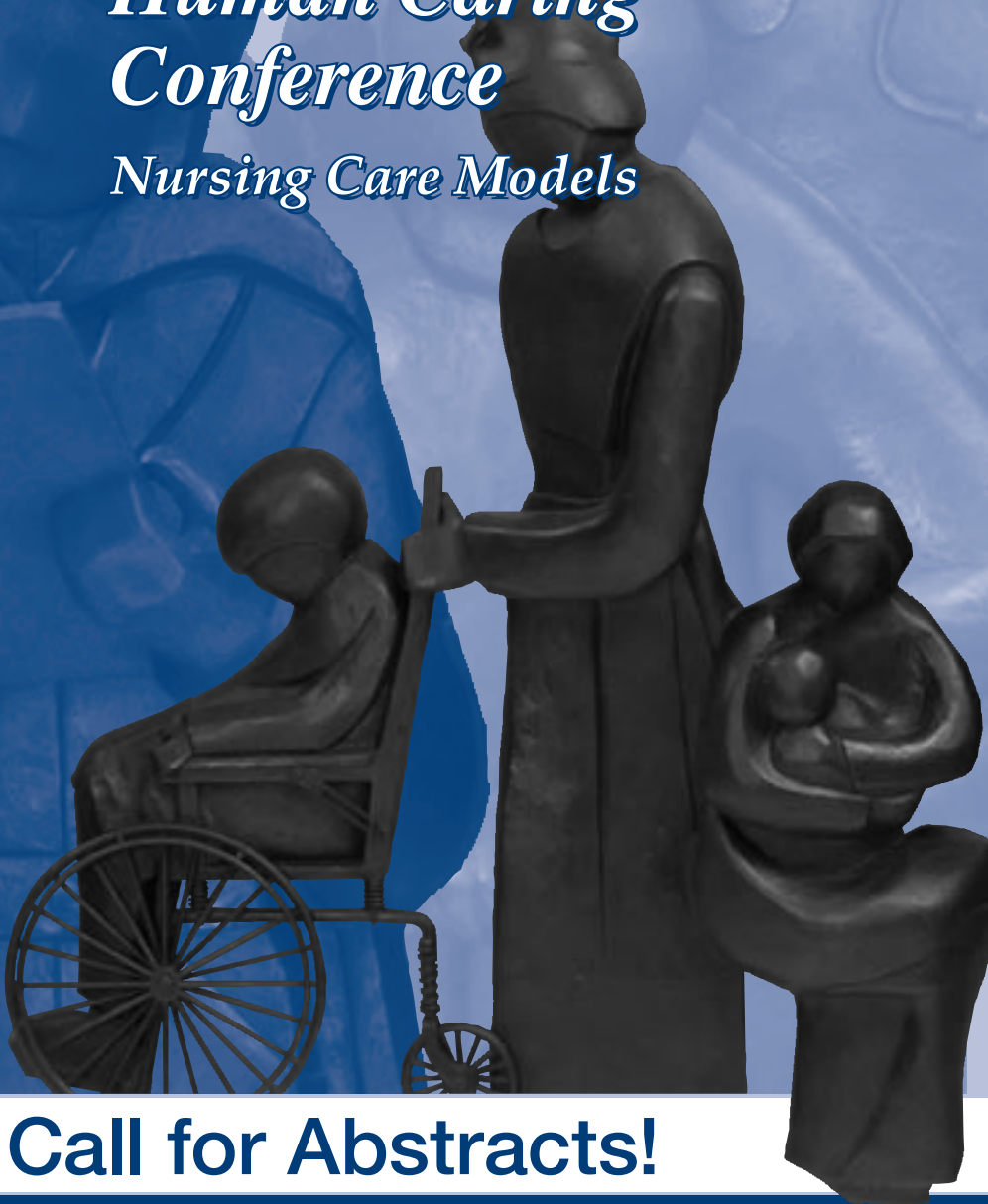

General Information

Conference description and theme

Applied nursing care models, in their evolution from caring theory to nursing practice, potentially vary according to regional nursing culture and vernacular interpretation of nursing care delivery systems. This call for abstracts invites an exploration and comparison of current and emerging applied nursing care models by addressing one or more of the following sub-themes:

- The ability of nurses to recognize and describe current or emerging models of nursing care in their practice, education, and research settings.
- Health outcomes of patient and family exposure to nursing care models.
- A nursing profession definition and evaluation of applied nursing care models.
- The economic impact of nursing care models on healthcare delivery.

Submission guidelines

- Abstracts may be submitted for podium and/or poster presentations.
- Abstracts should be 350 words or less. If accepted, the abstract will be published in the syllabus as submitted.

The primary presenter is responsible for the abstract content. Submission signifies the intent of the submitter(s) to present at the **June 2-5, 2010** conference. Presenters are expected to assume costs related to travel, accommodations, and registration.

Notification of accepted abstract(s) and commitment for presentation at the conference will be made by **Monday, November 23, 2009**.

Fees

All podium and poster presenters must register for the conference. Presenters are expected to assume costs related to travel, accommodations, and registration. Submission of an abstract signifies intent of the author(s) to present.
