# General Information

## Course Description

*27th Biennial Mayo Clinic Department of Dermatology Symposium*  
**September 11-12, 2009**

This 2009 CME Education Program will provide a multi-media approach to updating physicians about the current role of genetics in caring for dermatology patients with both common and rare dermatology disorders. Topics presented will include the newest technology of genetic testing with emphasis on uses practical for a dermatologist. The information presented will be relevant to dermatopathology, dermatology surgery, general and pediatric dermatology. Author, Rachel Simon, will provide insight into families' experience with a family member having an undiagnosed condition.

## Course Objectives

Upon conclusion of this program, participants should be able to:

- Use genetic testing for dermatologic disorders and identify testing availability.
- Recognize the emotional impact of an unknown diagnosis on the patient and family members.
- Interpret the role of newborn screening in possible pre-symptomatic diagnosis of dermatologic disorders.

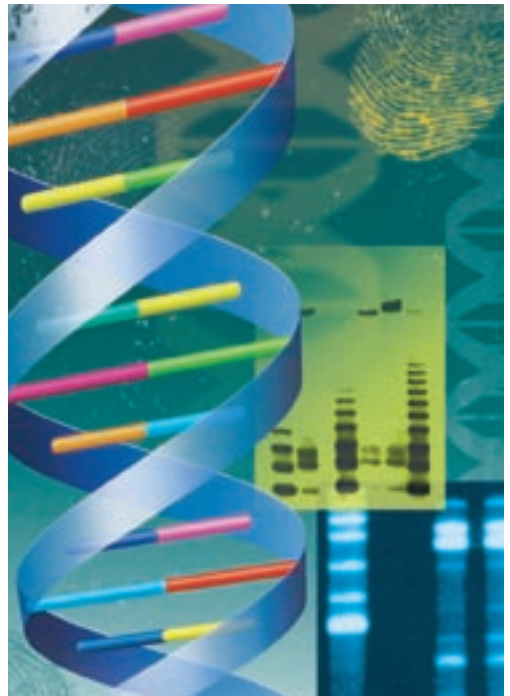
## *Travel*

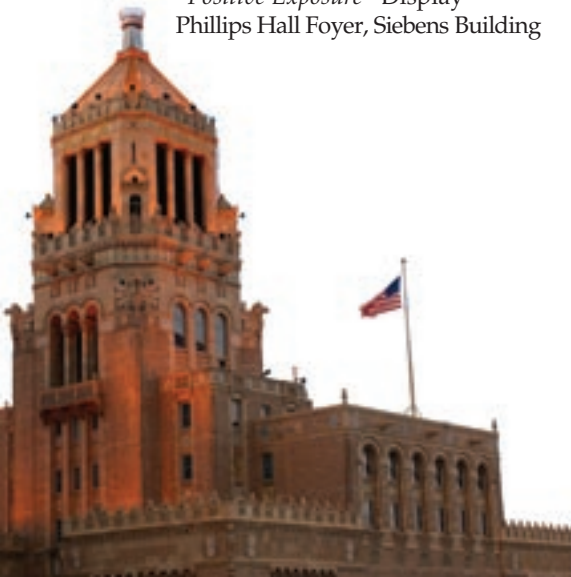
