This three-day course will highlight advancements in surgical gynecology, urogynecology, reconstructive surgery and chronic pain management for gynecologic surgeons, general gynecologists, and urologists with an interest in gynecologic reconstructive surgery.

- Identify uses of minimally invasive surgery in gynecologic procedures.
- Distinguish when it is appropriate to consult interventional radiology for post-operative surgical problems.
- Determine the best approach to reconstructive surgery (vaginal, laparoscopic, and open).
- Analyze complications resulting from gynecologic surgery and ways to prevent complications.
- Identify treatment options for obstructive defecation and solve overactive bladder and fail medical therapy.
