COURSE HIGHLIGHTS

This course is designed for practicing and academic emergency medicine physicians, primary care providers and allied health personnel interested in emergency medicine. The primary educational goal of this conference is to present topics which are seen in everyday emergency medicine practices that were not covered adequately in residency to practicing and academic emergency medicine physicians as well as for primary care. Audience participation will be encouraged through an interactive keypad response system as well as question and answer sessions. To provide an immediate opportunity for participants to practice the skills they have learned, an optional hands-on ultrasound techniques workshops on GYN, Vascular, abdominal, and Focused Abdominal Sonography Trauma (FAST) exam procedures will be offered (separate registration required; limit is 25 registrants).

COURSE LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, participants should be able to:

Pre-conference Ultrasound Course:

- Operate the ultrasound machine using the basic controls
- Identify the acoustic windows most appropriate for the FAST exam.
- Evaluate global contractility and identify pericardial effusions.

General Session:

- Form an evaluation plan for patients presenting to the Emergency Dept. with transient neurological deficits
- Identify which patients are eligible for post-resuscitation hypothermia treatment.
- Recognize patients with common toxidromes
- Discuss the risk and benefits of treating acute ischemic stroke patients with t-PA.
- Demonstrate the technique of continuous cardiac compression resuscitation.
- Differentiate between epileptic seizures and pseudo-seizures.
