

Celebration of Research 2019 Parking Instructions

Schools Traveling by School Van/Individual Vehicles

- Schools traveling by van, or individual vehicles, may park in the following city parking ramps: **Center Street Ramp, Civic Center Ramp, First Street Ramp, Second Street Ramp**

Parking validation will be provided ONLY for these four ramps. Individuals choosing to park in locations other than the Center Street, Civic Center, First Street, and Second Street Ramps are responsible for any fees or tickets incurred.

Vehicle Clearances for the validated ramps are as follows:

- **Center Street Ramp**- 7' Clearance
- **Civic Center Ramp**- 8' Clearance Level 1; 7' Clearance above Level 1
- **First Street Ramp**- 6' 7" All Entrances
- **Second Street Ramp**- 6'7" at 2nd Street Entrance; 6'5" at 3rd Street Entrance

Schools Traveling by School Bus

Transportation between Mayo Clinic Campuses

- **Coach buses will be provided to transport students between the Rochester campus of Mayo Clinic and Mayo Clinic Hospital – Rochester, Saint Marys Campuses at the following times:**
 - **From Rochester campus to Saint Marys Campus: 9:45 AM and 1:15 PM** (A Celebration of Research coach bus will pick-up at the bus shelter on 2nd Avenue east side next to the Hilton blood bank parking lot and drop off at the city cab stand in front of the Joseph Building across from the Canadian Honker along 2nd Street SW.)
 - **From Saint Marys Campus to Rochester Campus: 11:50 AM and 2:25 PM** (A Celebration of Research coach bus will pick up at the city cab stand in front of the Joseph Building across from Canadian Honker along 2nd Street SW and drop off at Southeast corner of the Hilton building [2nd Ave SW and 3rd St SW].)
 - Schools traveling via coach bus to Saint Marys campus tours should remain with their tour guide throughout their tours and while boarding/disembarking the buses. Teachers are responsible for making sure their school group is accounted for. Tour guides will ensure that school groups, not individuals, are properly boarded before departures from either campus.
 - In an effort to alleviate any vehicle congestion at the city cab stand, please note the coach buses will pull into the boarding/disembarking areas one at a time.
