Dr. Jason Sicklick is an award-winning surgeon-scientist, NCI/NIH-funded U01/R01 principal investigator, NIH T32 program director, Professor of Surgery, Adjunct Professor of Pharmacology, Executive Vice Chair of Research (Department of Surgery), and Associate Program Director (General Surgery Residency), as well as Leader of the Sarcoma Disease Team and Co-Leader of the CCSG Structural and Functional Genomics Program at the UC San Diego Moores Cancer Center. He previously served as the Deputy Director of the Biorepository and Tissue Technology Shared Resource (BTTSR). Dr. Sicklick is an active member of the *NCCN* Soft Tissue Sarcoma/GIST and Committee, as well as the SARC Scientific Steering Committee. He also chairs the Clinical Oncology and Therapeutics Study Section of the Israel Cancer Research Fund and is Associate Section Editor of Sarcoma for *Surgical Oncology Insight*. He received his medical degree from the UCLA School of Medicine, completed his general surgery residency at The Johns Hopkins Hospital, and completed a fellowship in surgical oncology at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center. He joined the UC San Diego Division of Surgical Oncology at Moores Cancer Center in 2010.
